## Tuesday Evening Ladies League - Rules & Etiquette

Tuesday evening ladies golf is designed to be a fun, non-competitive and social evening on the course for everyone! Here are a couple of tips to help keep the round fun and enjoyable not just for you but for your playing partners as well as the groups in front of and behind you!

- Be on time for your tee time! Groups should be at the tee and ready to play 5 minutes before their scheduled tee time so that you are ready to go when the group in front of you has cleared the tee.
- Play "Ready Golf" at all times. This simply means that players should play when ready rather than adhering to the formal rules of "furthest from the hole plays first". This is done to keep things moving and to keep delays to a minimum.
- Don't spend any more than 2 minutes looking for lost golf balls! They make plenty more everyday!
- Always keep pace with the group in front of you! Don't ever worry about the group behind you as their job is to keep up with you!! You should never be more than ½ a hole behind the group in front of you at any point during your round. If you are, you are out of position and need to pick up your pace.
- Once you have reached 10 strokes on any hole, it is suggested that you pick up your ball and continue
  on to the green if you have not already reached it. Feel free to drop your ball there and putt out to finish
  the hole! Taking more than 10 or 12 strokes per hole will not only slow your group down but may also
  be frustrating and not so fun for you! The point of the evening is to enjoy yourself, not leave you frustrated!
- If you and your partner are both newer golfers, don't be afraid to play a scramble or alternate shot format between you on "regular golf" nights! This will make it more fun for you and your playing partners will be more than happy to accommodate that! There is no big prize money on the line!
- Expected pace of play is no more than 2 hours for 9 holes!
- Don't ever hesitate to ask questions of your playing partners or of the staff! There is no such thing as a stupid question!
- SMILE! HAVE FUN! LAUGH! RELAX! THIS IS YOUR NIGHT OUT OF THE HOUSE!
